## ORDINANCE 2021-58

## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RIDGE AT HEATH BROOK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 190, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR FUNCTIONS AND POWERS OF THE DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR THE INITIAL BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY and an effective date.

WHEREAS, Forestar (USA) Real Estate Group, Inc. ("Petitioner") has petitioned the City Council for the City of Ocala, Florida ("City") to adopt an ordinance establishing the boundaries of the Ridge at Heath Brook Community Development District ("District") pursuant to Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, and granting certain special powers; and

WHEREAS, the City, in determining whether to establish the District boundaries, has considered and finds that all statements contained in the Petition to Establish the Ridge at Heath Brook Community Development District ("Petition") are true and correct; and

WHEREAS, the City has considered and finds that the establishment of the District is not inconsistent with any applicable element or portion of the applicable Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City has considered and finds that the area of land within the District is a sufficient size, is sufficiently compact, and is sufficiently contiguous to be developed as a functional interrelated community; and

WHEREAS, the City has considered and finds that the District is an available alternative for delivering the community development services and facilities to the area that will be served by the District; and

WHEREAS, the City has considered and finds that the community development services and facilities of the District will not be incompatible with the capacity and uses of existing local and regional community development services and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City has considered and finds that it is not problematic for the subject area to be served by a separate special-district government; and

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public hearing on the Petition was held prior to the adoption of this Ordinance establishing the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Ocala, Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1: AUTHORITY. This ordinance is adopted in compliance with and pursuant to the Uniform Community Development Act of 1980, Chapter 190, Florida Statutes (2020).

SECTION 2: DISTRICT NAME. There is hereby created a community development district situated entirely within incorporated Ocala, Florida, which District shall be known as the "Ridge at Heath Brook Community Development District."

SECTION 3: EXTERNAL BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT. The external boundaries of the District are described in Exhibit A attached hereto.

SECTION 4: FUNCTIONS AND POWERS. The powers and functions of the District are described in Chapter 190, Florida Statutes (2020), as may be amended from time to time. The Charter of the District shall be as set forth in Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, as created by general law. The District's Board of Supervisors may further exercise certain additional powers to finance, fund, plan, establish, acquire, construct, reconstruct, enlarge or extend, equip, operate and maintain systems and facilities for (a) parks and facilities for indoor and outdoor recreational, cultural, and educational uses; and (b) security, including but not limited to, guardhouses, fences and gates, electronic intrusion-detection systems, and patrol cars, when authorized by applicable governmental agencies; except that the District may not exercise any police power, but may contract with the City for an increased level of such services within the proposed District boundaries, all as authorized and described by Section 190.012(2), Florida Statutes.

SECTION 5: BOARD OF SUPERVISORS. The five persons designated to serve as initial members of the District's Board of Supervisors are:

SECTION 6: SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Ordinance, or the application thereof, is finally determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable, such provision shall be deemed to be severable and the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect provided that the invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision is not material to the logical and intended interpretation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and adoption pursuant to general law.
